SPRING FELINE SPECIALS: Add a feline friend to your home this spring and give an adult or senior cat a chance to enhance your life!

During the months of April and May a variety of specials are being offered on adult and senior cats that are just waiting for their forever homes.

***Adult cats (1+ years):** 50 % off adoption fee & a certificate for next annual veterinary checkup.

***Senior cats (10+ years):** The adoption fee is waived & veterinary care is covered. Seniors are often difficult to place in permanent homes due to their age and potential veterinary needs. Our long term foster care program addresses this issue by making sure each senior has had a veterinary checkup and update prior to adoption and that any annual and emergency veterinary needs while in foster care are covered under a special program.

***Long haired cats** will additionally receive a certificate for one grooming session.
